

Shepshed High School Results July 2016

Students arrive at Shepshed High School with just over two terms left until their end of Key Stage exams. These exams measure the progress made by the students during years 3, 4, 5 and 6. Although the progress made overall between the end of year 2 and the May of year 6 is slightly below national average, internal data shows that students make more than expected progress during their time in year 6 at Shepshed High School, as commented on by Ofsted in 2015. We believe that this is down to students being taught by secondary specialist teachers in all of their subjects combined with carefully planned intervention programmes that help us to support the needs of every student. The headline results are published below.
