## **EXAMINATION REGULATIONS – A SUMMARY**

**Students must bring enough equipment** to take part in the exams - pens, pencils, rulers, rubbers, etc. You cannot rely on borrowing equipment. Pencil cases **MUST** be transparent and only contain the required equipment. You could use a clear bag or container.

You must not bring in paper of any sort unless you have been told to by your teacher.

**ONLY BLUE or BLACK INK** is allowed to answer questions. **TIPPEX** is not allowed.

**MOBILE PHONES ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE EXAM ROOMS and should be left switched off in bags – NOT ON SILENT. PERSONAL STEREOS, MP3 players etc** are also not allowed.

Having a mobile phone or any other unauthorised material in their possession, **WILL LEAD TO DISQUALIFICATION** of the candidate by the exam board.

**BAGS** should be left at the front of the Sports Hall, and at the front/back of other exam rooms as directed by invigilators. **COATS/JACKETS and BASEBALL CAPS** must be removed and left at the front/back of the exam room.

**DRINKS** can be taken into the exam room but they should be small clear bottles with the label removed.

**EXAM ROOMS and SEATING** There should be **NO TALKING** once you are in the exam room and candidates should proceed to their allotted seat in silence. Exam rooms and seating arrangements will be available on the exam notice-board and/or in departments. Candidates should ensure that they know when and where they are taking their exams, by referring to their entry statements and further information on the exam notice-board. If you have an exam in the Sports Hall you should remain in the foyer until told to proceed to the exam room.

### **BEHAVIOUR**

Behaviour in examinations must be above suspicion. **Do not** turn round and look at other candidates. This will be seen as suspicious. **Do not** communicate in any way with another candidate. If you need something, just put your hand up. You must stay for the whole of the examination; you will not be allowed to leave early. Having finished your exam, re-read your script - it can make the difference between one grade and a higher one. Students found writing on desks will have to stay behind to clean it off.
